Whether you're a **word search** savant, a Scrabble[®] connoisseur or a puzzle junkie, a devious word search forged by **The GridKeeper** awaits you.

The GridKeeper is the silent architect of a word search gone rogue. A word search so twisted that not all words want to be found.

As the curator of perplexing paths, hidden words and mischievous misdirection, The GridKeeper leads you through a series of increasingly complex grids.

These grids contain a **myriad of secrets** for you to uncover.

Buried in layers are two secret transmissions.

Decode both and you'll have access to a password that unlocks The Grid beyond the book.

This is your **invitation** to play detective in a hybrid world where letters are missing, meanings are masked and every solution feels earned.

Each missing letter is a test, and each solved grid a step closer to unveiling what The GridKeeper guards in silence.

> Hence, The GridKeeper does not seek fame. He only seeks loyal **solvers**, like yourself.

And if you are one of those who manages to reach the end, you may well discover what the GridKeeper has truly been hiding.

Enter the Labyrinth

The GridKeeper has turned the alphabet into a twisted trap. He has woven words into a fragmented maze of warped design, each hidden word a step deeper into a literary labyrinth, with not one, but two, secret messages to decode.

The alphabet's been fractured. The answers lie between the cracks. You'll fill gaps with letters, completing each puzzled grid. Every letter you place shapes the puzzle - and seals your fate.

But two letters are held back - "bookend" clues to a mystery word.

The catch? You'll need to decode each hidden word using only its total letter values and those two elusive bookend letters. However, that is just the start of your quest.

Each hidden word has one letter that accumulates into a secret message. And unlocking that secret message leads you to decode the final message.

Themed categories like "It's Alive" or "Found in Space" lure you into finding red herrings and bogus words that only deepen the chaos.

It's not just a word search - it's a scramble through a devious mind, while a final secret waits in silence, watching your every move.

So sharpen your mind.
Follow the clues.
Unmask the words.
Decode the transmissions.
Trust your instincts.
And enter The Grid.

The Grid is Not One - It's a Hundred

One hundred devious grids await your decoding skills.

Grab your pencil and eraser, and enter The Grid.

Each letter you'll write might stick, yet will often end in eraser dust!

Impatient? - Quick Start Here ...

From the bottom of a grid ...

- 1. Pick a letter to write into the grid
- 2. Find a suitable blank to complete a word
- 3. Write the letter and circle the word
- 4. Mark off the letter as used
- 5. Repeat until all blanks are filled.

Two "bookend" letters will remain untouched. Find the hidden word matching these remaining letters.

Detailed Instructions

Within each grid, a **secret word** is hidden in plain sight. Your first step is to uncover that secret word.

You do this by first eliminating misleading letters.

You will have a set of letters to place within a grid's empty cells.

Determine the most suitable letter to fill each empty cell.

Every grid will have up to 24 letters missing.

The deeper you get, the more letters will need to be eliminated.

Hints within blank grid cells will guide your letter placement:

[1-3]: point value of the missing letter

[v]: only a vowel goes here.

[blank]: clueless.

Fill all of the empty cells to expose words hidden across, downwards and the occassional diagonal. Thankfully, there are no backwards (reverse) words!

Once you have placed all the letters,

two remaining letters will denote the secret word.

These are "bookend" letters - not always in first-last order.

Using these bookend letters, find the matching word in the grid.

The word will start with and/or end with those letters.

The secret word must match the category for the grid. To determine the category, examine the words you found, (especially those in the corners).

Commonalities between those words will help you determine the category. However, although about a dozen words will match the category, many other words are "bogus".

The boxes beneath each grid are followed by a number.

The number must match the total value of the letters in the secret word.

Write down the **secret word**, one letter per box.

With the word written into the boxes, you will notice that one box is highlighted. This **secret letter** will be part of The GridKeeper's <u>first</u> **secret message**.

Doing so correctly for all the grids will eventually help you to reveal The GridKeeper's entire **secret message**.

This first message will yield the clue to decoding his final message.

If you'd like to keep score, tally up the value of all the secret words.

Deduct five points if you used a clue.


Deduct ten points if the word does not match the solution.

The perfect score for the entire book is 112 points.

Example

In this example, at least 16 words have been found:
YACHT, SATELLITE, ROCKET, SLEIGH, CART, ESCALATOR, TRACKS
plus AMPHIBIOUS VEHICLE, FREIGHT TRAIN, MOTOR HOME.
DENSITY, CLOTHES and PROMOTION are "bogus" words or "red herrings".
The common category was determined to be "Vehicles".
The remaining letters [I] and [Z] are the "bookends".
The value of the secret word is 20 points.
Wordy knowledge was used to figure out that [Z] started the hidden word.
ZAMBONI (vehicle) was found to be the secret word.

The [O] from [ZAMBONI] will be part of The GridKeeper's secret message.



Solutions with the locations of hidden words are visualized online.

Decode The GridKeeper's First Secret Message.

When you have completed all 100 grids and obtained 100 letters you now must decode The GridKeeper's **first message**.

Unscramble the 100 secret letters to decode the message using this clue:

58?51217?6?6??828?56

This message will give you the **second message**. Follow the instructions for your reward.

Once you've decoded <u>both</u> of the The GridKeeper's transmissions, scan this QR code to see if you've unlocked the next layer of The Grid. If the GridKeeper accepts your truth, your next adventure will begin online.





Secret Words

If you are stuck, all 100 secret words can be individually requested online.

Secret Messages

The GridKeeper's secret messages are never revealed. You must decode them - it's essential to the game.

Easter Eggs

The 30 special "easter eggs" are not shown. They are yours to discover, but can be found or validated online - your choice.

Hidden Words

The location of the 292 hidden words can be found online, grid by grid.

Epilogue

You've come far. Farther than most.
You've reached the final page.
Decoded the grids.
Solved all the secrets - or have you?

The Grid was never meant to be totally solved - instead to evolve.

Within each grid are more secrets - cleverly tucked away, waiting to be found.

Little treasures. Hidden patterns. Words that weren't meant to be seen.

Scattered like "easter eggs" across the puzzle fields.

Each grid hides a pattern - one that unlocks an online world.

The GridKeeper has left you two secret messages.

If you have decoded them both, then you now know The GridKeeper's intent.




